Advanced Listing Search

Welcome to the My AmeriCorps "Advanced Search" page, a quick and easy way to find AmeriCorps national service opportunities that are suited to your particular skills, interests, and circumstances.

The simplest advanced search involves three steps: selecting the issue area (or areas) of interest to you; selecting one or more geographic area where you would be interested in serving; and clicking the "Search" button.

To narrow down your search further, you have the option of entering additional information about yourself before clicking the "Search" button, such as the particular program you would like to participate in, any specialized skills you might have, and whether you are looking for full time, part time, or summer service opportunities. These optional questions appear toward the right side of the search form.

Clicking the "Search" button will take you to a listing of opportunities that fit the criteria you entered, including: the name and a brief description of the organization offering the position; the AmeriCorps program - State and National, VISTA or NCCC - that the opportunity is connected with; the dates accepting applications; and the location of the service opportunity. Links from the page will take you directly to a detailed description of the available position, as well as to an online application form. Remember, though, that to apply for a position, you must first create a profile. But don't worry - if you apply for an opportunity but haven't created a profile yet, you will still be asked to create one as part of the application process.



Currently serving the following counties: Butte, Glenn, Kern, Los Angeles, Sacramento, Siskiyou, Yolo, and Yuba.
