Welcome to the My AmeriCorps "Advanced Search" page, a quick and easy way to find AmeriCorps national service opportunities that are suited to your particular skills, interests, and circumstances.

The simplest advanced search involves three steps: selecting the issue area (or areas) of interest to you; selecting one or more geographic area where you would be interested in serving; and clicking the "Search" button.

Youth Investment Center

The Youth Investment Center program utilizes 40 AmeriCorps members as Youth Mentors and Volunteer Coordinators to assist foster youth in achieving academic success and developing life skills necessary for successful transition to adulthood. Outcomes for emancipated foster youth are bleak, tracking well below statewide results in high school completion, obtaining employment, and securing housing arrangements. However, foster youth are capable of achieving success in adulthood if they learn essential life skills, and AmeriCorps members will provide life skill activities to foster youth to prepare them for their transition towards a successful adulthood. Members are recruited from diverse neighborhoods and reflect the ethnic and socioeconomic profile of those they serve. YIC will also recruit foster care alumni using existing connections with the local high school, county agencies, and group homes. The use of former foster youth as AmeriCorps members will enrich the program by bringing diverse life experiences and knowledge of the foster care system into the pool of members.
