<ul> <li>In 2009, Sacramento babies were hospitalized for SBS or abusive head injuries. (~10 % of California cases)</li> <li>1 one year old &amp; 1 two year old were treated and released or transferred to a different hospital</li> </ul>

Sacramento County Statistics continued:

- In 2010, \_\_\_\_\_ Sacramento babies were hospitalized for SBS or abusive head injuries. (~9 % of California cases)
- On average, 1-2 cases per year of SBS fatalities are not counted in hospital data because the infant died at the scene.
